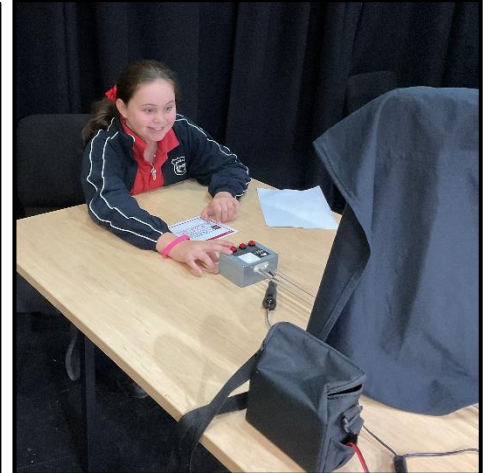
Canteen
